# EXHIBITORS CLASSES

## **LEADLINE**

Children are only eligible for leadline classes. Class will run with one rider or more.

ENTRY FEE: \$15

## **LEADLINE WALK/TROT**

Children eligible only for leadline classes. Handlers allowed but not mandatory for children just learning to trot on their own. Class will run with 1 rider or more and will be judged.

ENTRY FEE \$15

## **GROUND POLES HUNTER AND EQUITATION**

Open to eligible Jr./Amateur riders have not jumped above ground poles for 2 years at any show, and/or won less than 6 Champion ribbons. Professionals may audit the O/F portion of the ground pole classes only. The rider that accumulates the most points in the Introductory Hunter or Equitation divisions receives Champion or Reserve. In the event of a tie, O/F results are weighed more towards Champion or Reserve.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

## **CROSSRAILS HUNTER AND EQUITATION**

Open to Jr./Adult Amateur riders that have not shown above 2'0 for 2 years or received more than 6 Champion ribbons at Crossrails thru 2'0. Fences: X's.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

## **GREEN AS GRASS HUNTER**

Open to horses that have shown less than 1 year. Open to any rider. Trotting into lines and cantering out while showing a simple change of lead is permissible.

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

### **BEGINNER RIDER HUNTER AND EQUITATION**

Eligible to riders who haven't shown above 2'3". Riders are not eligible to compete if they have won 9 or more blue ribbons showing at this level. No oxers. Fences: 1'9"-2'0".

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

### **LIMIT HUNTER AND EQUITATION**

Open to Jr./Adult Amateur riders showing 2'6 and below. Fences: 2'3".

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

### **OPEN HUNTER**

Open to all riders. Open to horses who have shown for less than 2 consecutive years under 2'3".

Fences: 2'6".

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

### **GREEN AS GRASS JUMPER**

Open to any horse and rider showing less than 2 years at .80 and under. No Oxers. Fences: .70m. (2'3)

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

### **PUDDLE JUMPER**

Open to Jr. or Amateur showing less than 2 years at .80 and under. No Oxers. Fences: .70m.(2'3)

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

## **FUTURE JUMPER**

Open to any horse and rider showing 2'6". Jump combinations are allowed. Fences: .80m (2'6).

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS

## **TRAINING JUMPER**

Open to any horse and rider showing 2'6" and above. Fences: .80-.90 (2'6-2'9).

ENTRY FEE: \$25 PER CLASS



## **ATTIRE**

Proper show attire is strongly encouraged for all classes. Collared shirts are permitted for leadline through the Beginner division. Half chaps with paddock boots are permitted in all classes. All Riders are required to wear USEF approved head gear. Braiding is not required.

## **CLASSES**

USEF rules apply if not covered by Revolution Series. Management reserves the right to cancel, split or combine classes. Ribbons will be offered for each class. Prizes offered to Champion and Reserve Champion riders with at least 3 riders. Entry in the entire division is required for Champion and Reserve Champion eligibility. Exhibitors are expected to be prompt for their classes. 2-minute gate call rule will be enforced and followed. Exhibitors are ALL expected to follow good sportsman like behavior

## **STALLS**

Stalls and shavings can be reserved online or by calling/texting Ashley at 224-645-1744. Orders must be in one week prior to show. Stalls will be available after 3:30pm on Saturday

## **PLEASE NOTE:**

Cancellations after Monday at noon preceding the show (except for a Vet's excuse) are billed to the trainer. No outside shavings or straw – call early to order additional shavings. Stalls have concrete flooring and are not matted. Horse must have proof of updated Equine Influenza Virus, Equine Herpes Virus vaccinations and Coggins
